Co-ed Football: 25 students in Grades 7&8 participated in the co-ed football tournament. They all had a good day!

Principal's Report con't...

Grade 8's had their first visit to **Taunton Mills**. They go once each month.

Grade 8's will have 2 visits to Father Leo J. Austin and on November 14th they will be doing a tour of the school.

The school had their first **Rosary visit** and this will continue each month (it is the third Monday of each month).

Grade 7 & 8's had their first health shots.

Grades 1 & 2 went to Nature's Bounty Farm

Grade 3's went to Pickering Pioneer Village

Kindergarten Classes went to Pingles' Farm

Math: the school is continuing with balanced numeracy in every class. It's all about understanding numbers — recalling facts, strategies for problem solving.

Grades 3-5 are using Jo Boaler's Mathematical Mindset.

The Primary students love math! On the EQAO 90% of Grade 3 students answered that they love math and they can do math. This percentage drops to 40% on the Grade 6 EQAO. Part of success is the mindset of the child — if they think they can do it, they will do better!

The teachers spent their PA Day on October 22nd doing

Ms. Hadden provided a document from the Ministry titled A Parent's Guide to the Fundamentals of Math: Grades 1-8.

Fresh from the Farm Fundraiser: some families participated in both fundraisers, so only did one. The school sold \$1900 in Fresh from the Farm and the school will receive \$740 from the sales.

Laura Secord Chocolates fundraiser: The goal was to sell 250 cases of chocolates (increase from last year). However, the sales came in under this year. The school sold \$19,444.00 in chocolate and the school will receive \$8,800.00. There was \$743.00 spent on prizes.

Principal's Report con't	Christmas Market: 2nd Annual Christmas Market will be held on November 30 th , 2018. Everyone is welcome. Currently there are 30 paid vendors. The school will accept up to 50 vendors. There will be a tea room, photos with Santa (photos available instantly). There is a Facebook page which can be shared. The proceeds of the Christmas Market will go to the school's Christmas Outreach and Technology (Chromebooks).
	Book Fair : The book fair will be here November 7 th - 9 th . On November 8 th , the book fair will be open from 5pm to 8pm during Parent/Teacher Interviews.
	The week of November 12 th – 15 th the school will be celebrating Durham Catholic District School Board's 50th Anniversary . There are announcements & events planned each day with a retro theme to 1968 (or close to it!). Monday: 1968 Just Dance Party Tuesday: Hot Dog Day Wednesday: Retro Movie Day (Winnie the Pooh & the Blustery Day; Herbie the Love Bug; Chitty Chitty Bang Bang; Oliver) Thursday: Pep Rally – dress in 1960's clothes Friday: PA Day
	Pavement Painting: this is being done the evening of November 12 th to spruce up the yard – it will be bright & colourful. There will be something painted on the pavement for each Division: Wall Ball; Track for bikes; Movement Break; Snakes & Ladders; Hopscotch. The cost is approx. \$1,900.00 and it is guaranteed for the first couple of years (potential damage by snow removal). The money from the fun lunches has been allocated to cover this cost.
5. Chair's Report	a. Ice Cream Social costs was \$271.00 - \$200+GST for the truck and the ice-cream and cost of sidewalk chalk. Some of the feedback was that it was too soon after Meet the Teacher night.
